Young Voices 2024

Clubs

Clubs will be starting next week. If your child has been allocated a place in a club, you would have received an email from the school asking you to submit a form to confirm the collection arrangements from the club. If you have not yet returned the form, please do so over the weekend.

Thurrock Council Childcare Reforms and Parent Entitlement Survey

As you may be aware, the government are introducing significant changes in childcare, with increased 15 and 30 hours childcare support for children from 9 months to 2 years and wraparound care for all primary aged children. In order to help the Council to identify a clearer understanding and need for the type and details of childcare parents require, we are asking parents to complete a survey of need.

What are the Childcare Reforms and Parent Entitlement

Working parents will be supported through an extension of the current funded childcare offer. Currently, parents who work more than 16 hours a week and earn less than £100,000 are entitled to 30 hours free childcare a week for children aged three to four.

The scheme is now expanding so that working parents of all children over the age of nine months will also be entitled to funded 30 hours of childcare. Before and after school childcare is also to be extended to provide more locally available places.

From April 2024 - working parents of two-year-olds will be able to access 15 hours of funded childcare.

From September 2024 - 15 hours of funded childcare will be extended to all children from the age of nine months.

From September 2025 - Working parents of children under the age of five will be entitled to 30 hours funded childcare per week.

From September 2024 - Thurrock are aiming to provide additional wraparound (from 8-9am / 3-6pm) childcare places for children from Reception to Year 6.

From September 2026 - All schools able to offer 8am to 6pm wraparound on their own or in partnership.
