News ...

Welcome back -

It has been fantastic to have the children back in school this week. After the break, the children who have returned have demonstrated that they are focused and ready to learn. Walking around classes this week has been a highlight for me. Seeing the children begin to explore their new curriculums has been great. The children have embraced the changes we have made to our daily practices and many are excited for the opportunities and experiences that they will have the chance to fulfil during the current academic year. The first experience of the year will take place next Friday when the children in Year 4 take part in a Forensic Science Workshop. I have attached a separate document to the newsletter email with a list of other opportunities and experiences already planned for the year - this list will expand as the year continues. Our first experience that parents have the chance to be a part of will take place on Friday 20th October where the parents will be invited to visit the school's Museum Event. Parents will be able to explore a range of exhibitions displaying the work the children have covered during Black History Month.

Drop off and Collection -

Last year, the morning registers were open from 8:40am until 9:00am. Many children arrived within the first ten minutes of this period and had to wait for their formal learning to begin at 9:00am. To ensure that our children maximise their time at school, I would like to remind parents that the registration period will now run from 8:40am and will close at 8:50am. This will mean that learning sessions can begin promptly and we utilise the time the children are in school as effectively as possible. If your child arrives after 8:50am, the gates will be locked and they will need to report to the office as they will be marked as late.

Pick up time will remain at 3:30pm. Last year, concerns were raised by the local safeguarding forum about the number of adults in and around school grounds after school. To mitigate any potential problems, we have decided to lock the red and back external gates at 3:40pm. Staff will also be more present at the beginning and the end of the day. The internal red gates will be reopened at 4:15pm to allow for parents to collect from boosters or clubs; however, the back gates (accessed from Flint Street) will remain closed.

Curriculum Meetings -

During the next few weeks, I will be arranging Curriculum Meetings for each year group. During the week beginning Monday 18th September 2023 and Monday 25th September 2023, the teachers from each year group will hold a Curriculum Meeting. The meetings will allow the teachers to explain all the information linked to curriculum, homework and the expectations for your child's new year group. I will also be at each of the meetings and will discuss a range of matters linked to the school including our new behaviour approach and rewards. Each year group will hold two meetings: one at 9am and one at 6pm. If you are unable to attend either meeting, you will be able to access all the paperwork and presentations on the school's website by Monday 9th October 2023.
