#### News ...

Census Day - This coming Thursday is Census Day. This is one of the occasions during the academic year when the number of pupils having a school lunch is recorded and reported. The number reported determines the school's funding for the following year. We would ask that all parents encourage their children to choose to have a school dinner, rather than bringing in a packed lunch from home. To incentivise the children we have decided to provide them with a special menu for this lunch - this pizza-themed menu can be found on the front page of the newsletter. As a further incentive, every child in each class who orders a lunch next Thursday will be entered into a raffle to win an Amazon Fire Tablet. If the school is able to add just a few more children to the Key Stage 1 numbers next Thursday, the school could gain thousands of pounds in additional funding for 2024 - 2025, which I could use to improve the school in a range of ways. I would like to thank parents in advance for their support with this matter.

World Smile Day - On Friday 6th October 2023, the school will be celebrating World Smile Day. It is easy to listen all the negative things that take place locally and nationally and let them get you down; however, we are determined to make next Friday a day of joy and smiles! The children are invited to attend school wearing something that makes them smile. The teachers will be planning some activities with the hope that they make the children smile too. To start the day off in the right way, we will be playing upbeat music as the children enter the school via the main school gate. We look forward to seeing lots of smiles next week!

Curriculum Meetings - During the past two weeks, teachers from all year groups have held Curriculum Meetings. The meetings have allowed the teachers to provide all the information linked to their year group's curriculum, homework and expectations. I have also attended these meetings to discuss a range of matters linked to the school including our new behaviour approach, rewards, Seesaw and communication.
